Bishop Olson’s Letter of Sept 25 is available on the diocesan and our parish website. His Excellency has renewed the norms of June 26, scil.

- We are still allowed to operate at 50% building capacity.
- Persons over two years of age must wear a face mask while in the buildings.
- Members of the same household may sit together.
- Others should keep a distance of at least three feet.
- Outside of the buildings, keep a distance of **at least six feet**
- Do not congregate after Mass.
- Those who are high risk, sick, or who have been exposed are not to come to Mass.
